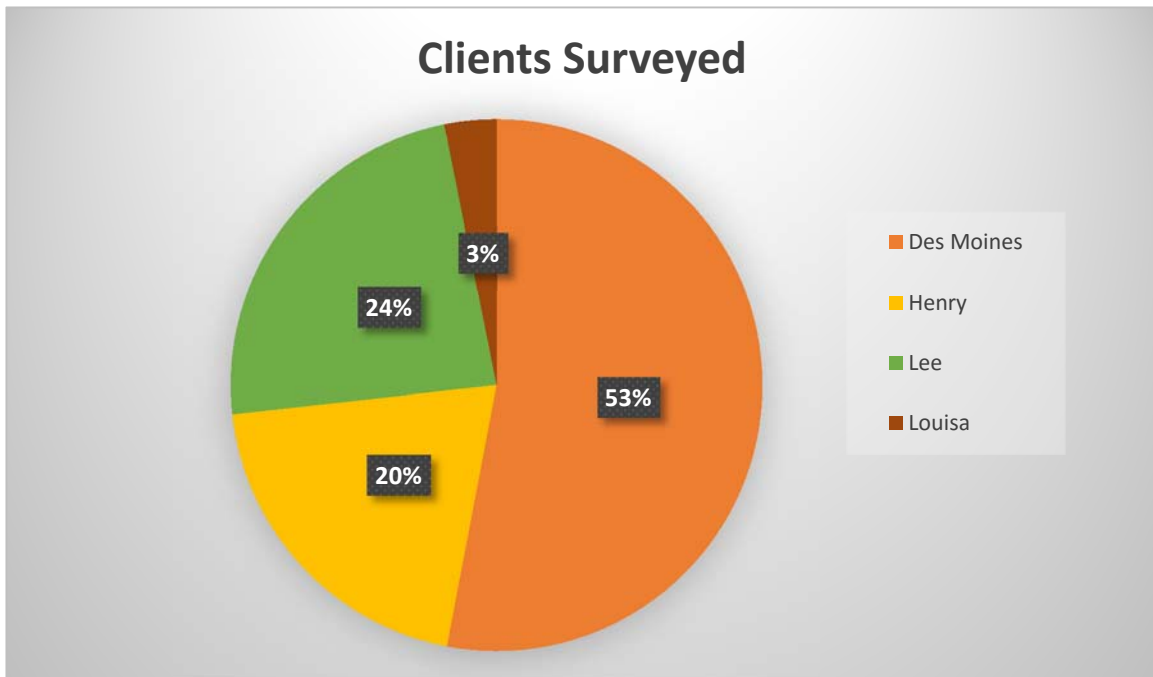

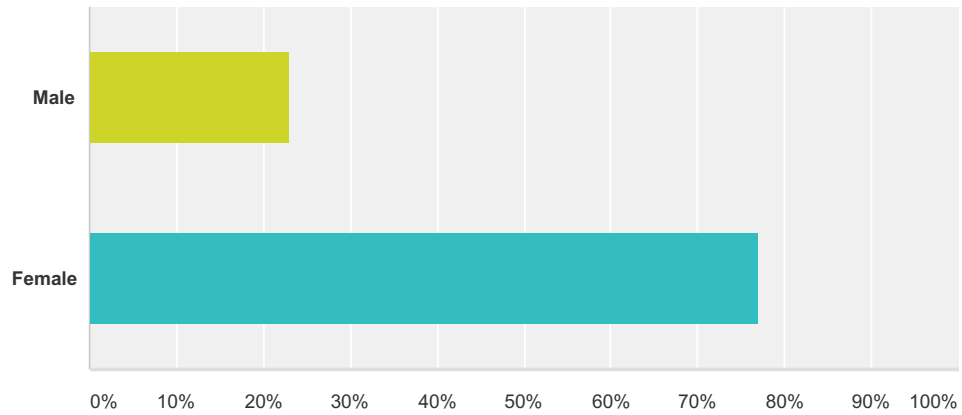

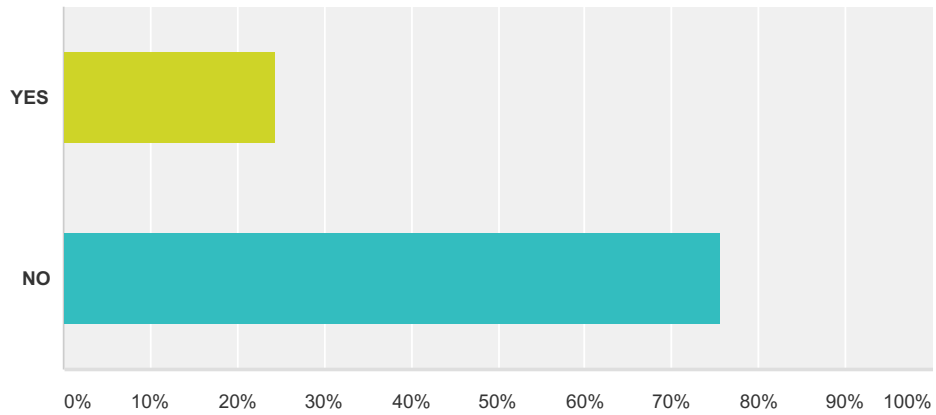

Q4 4. Are you aged 55 or over?

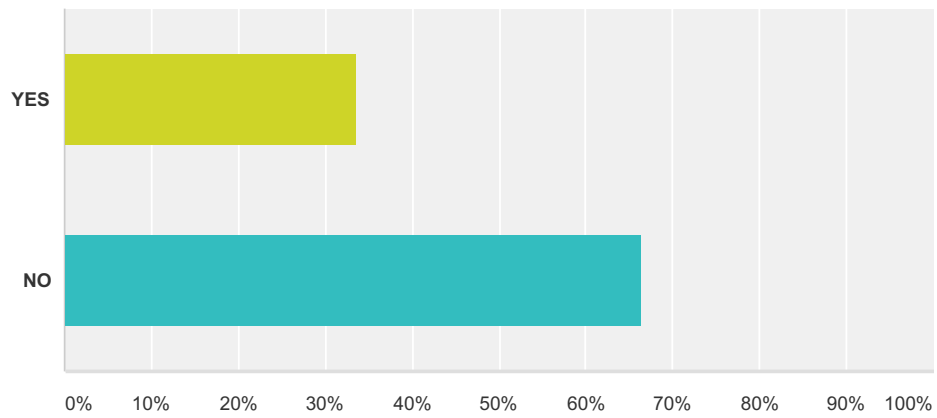

Q5 5. Are you married or living with a partner?

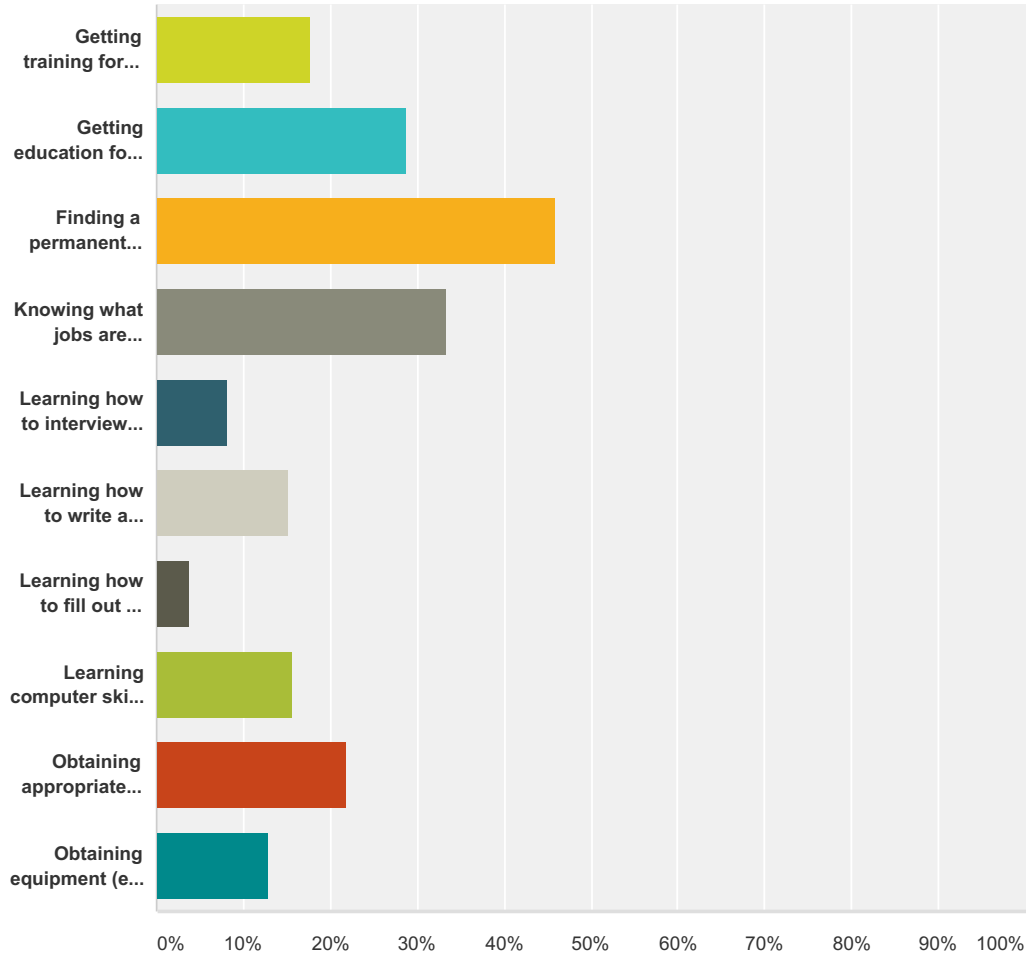

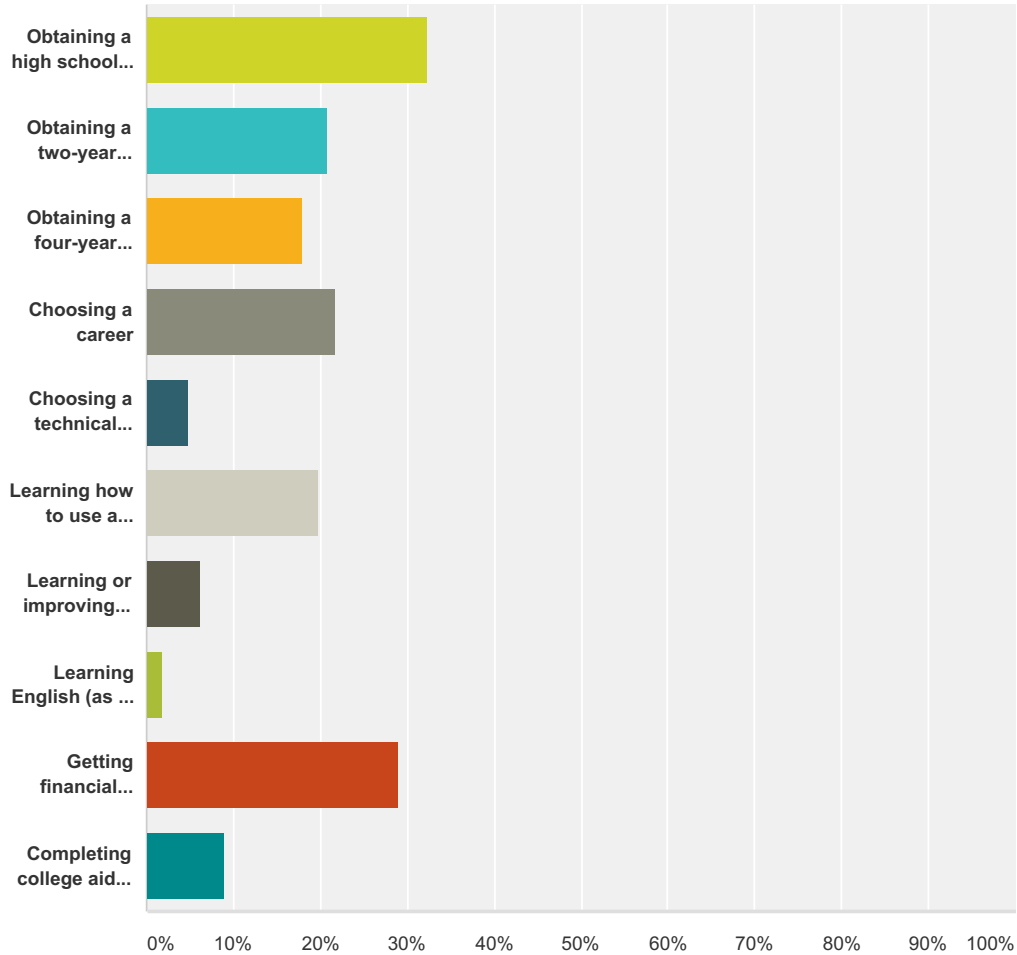

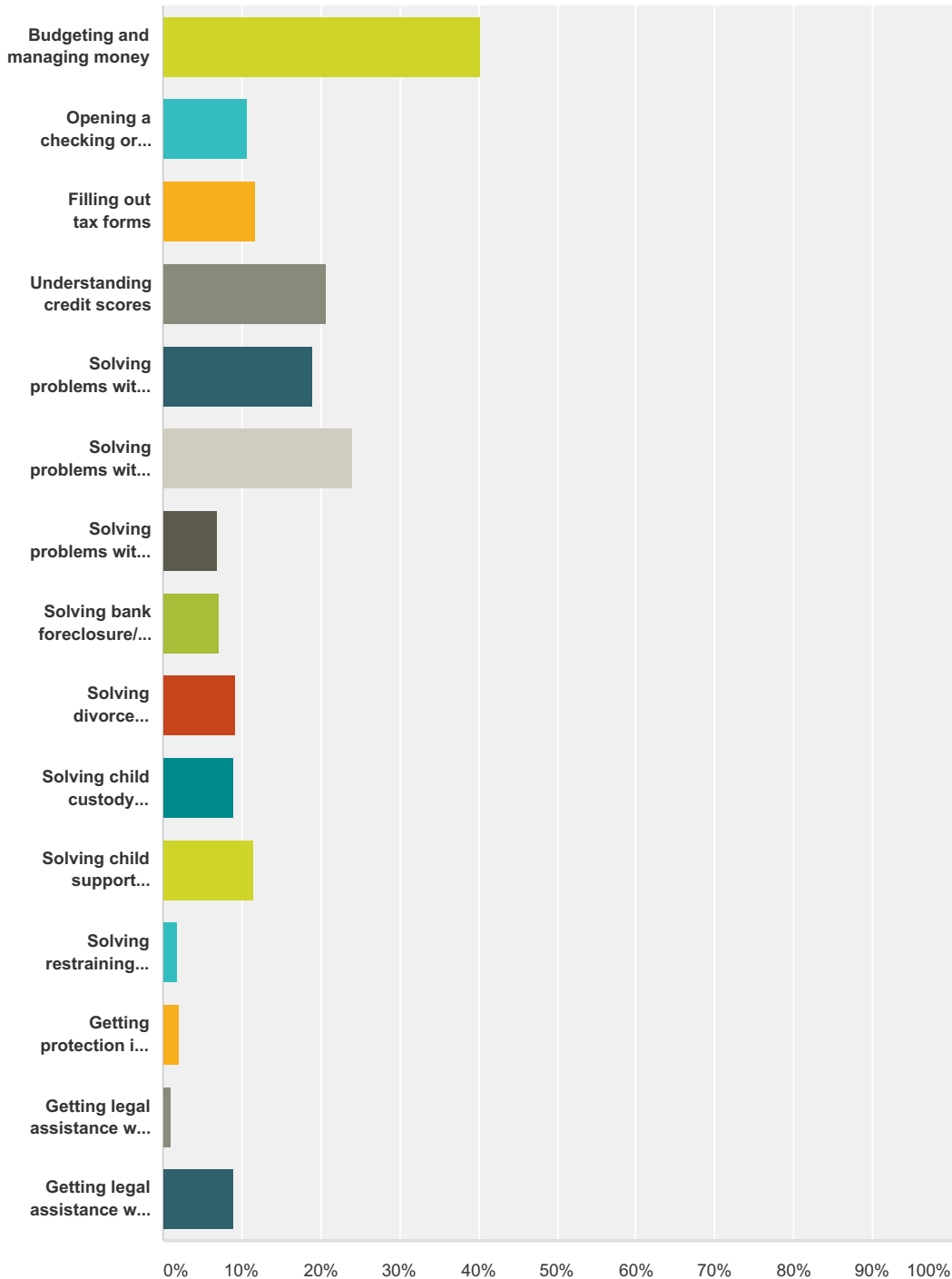

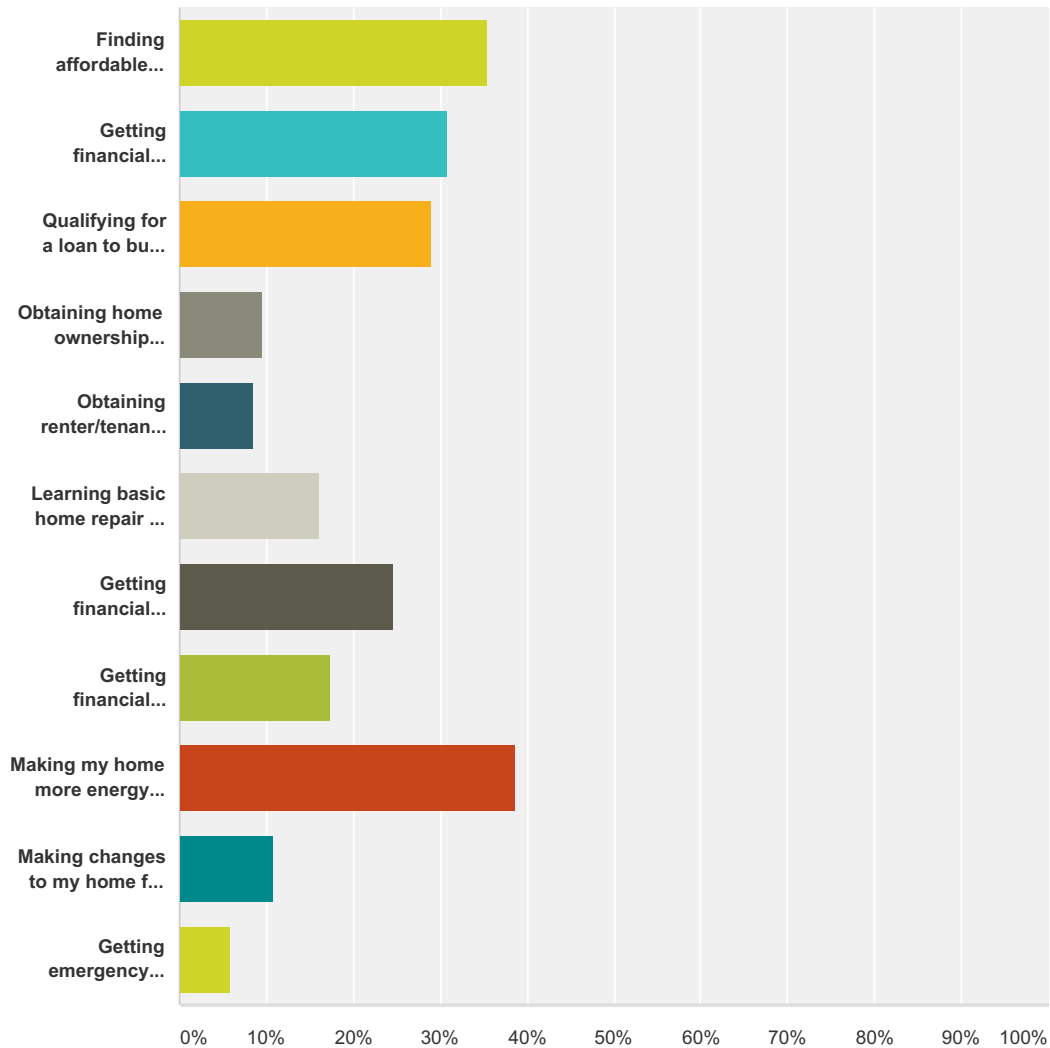

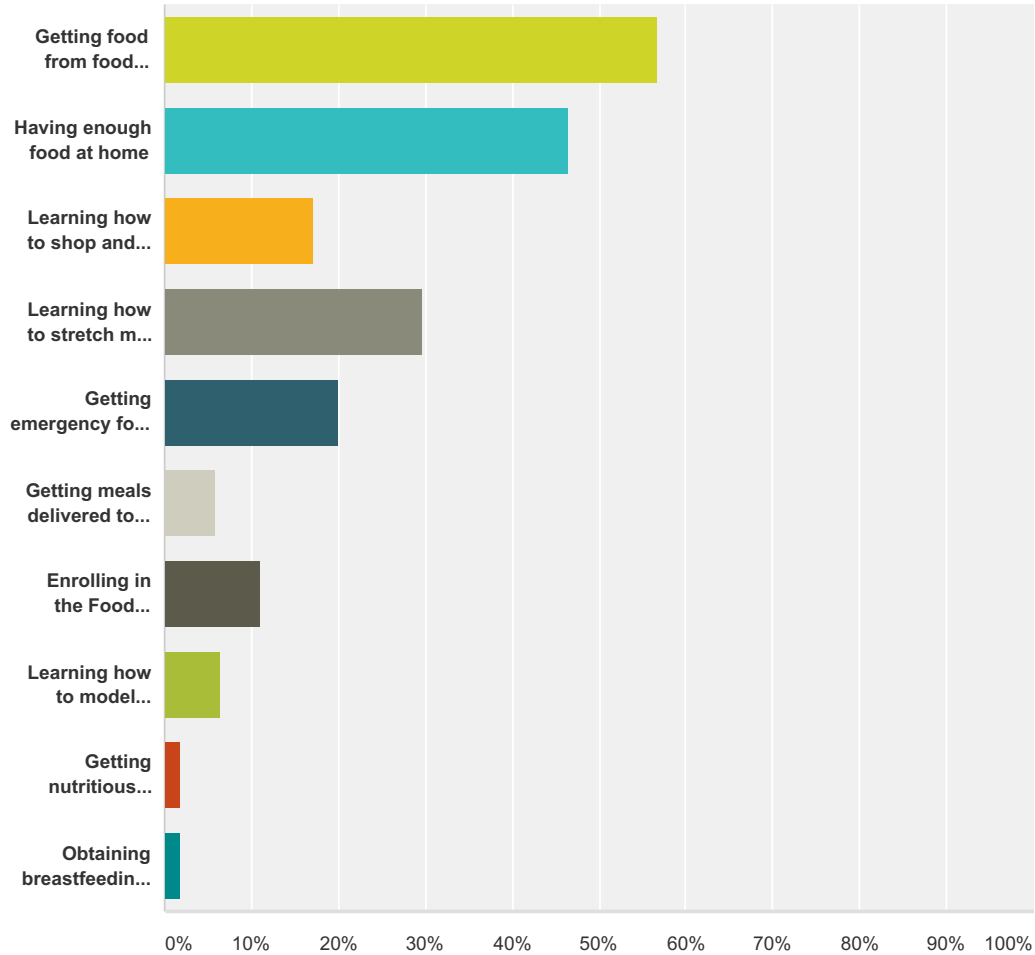

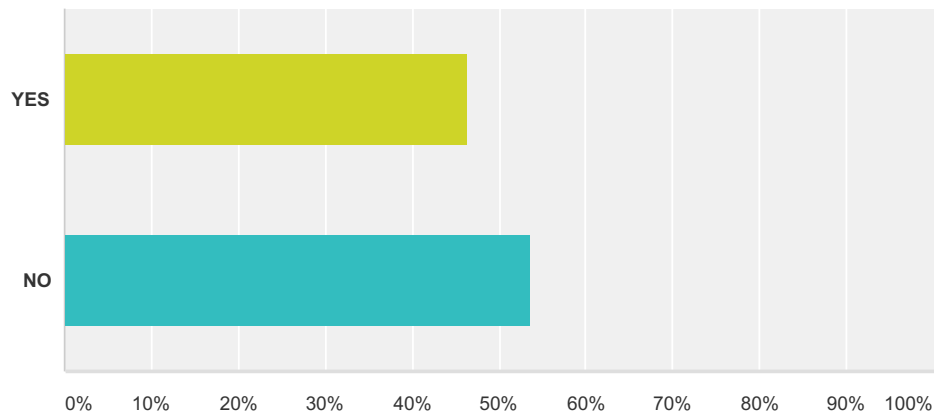

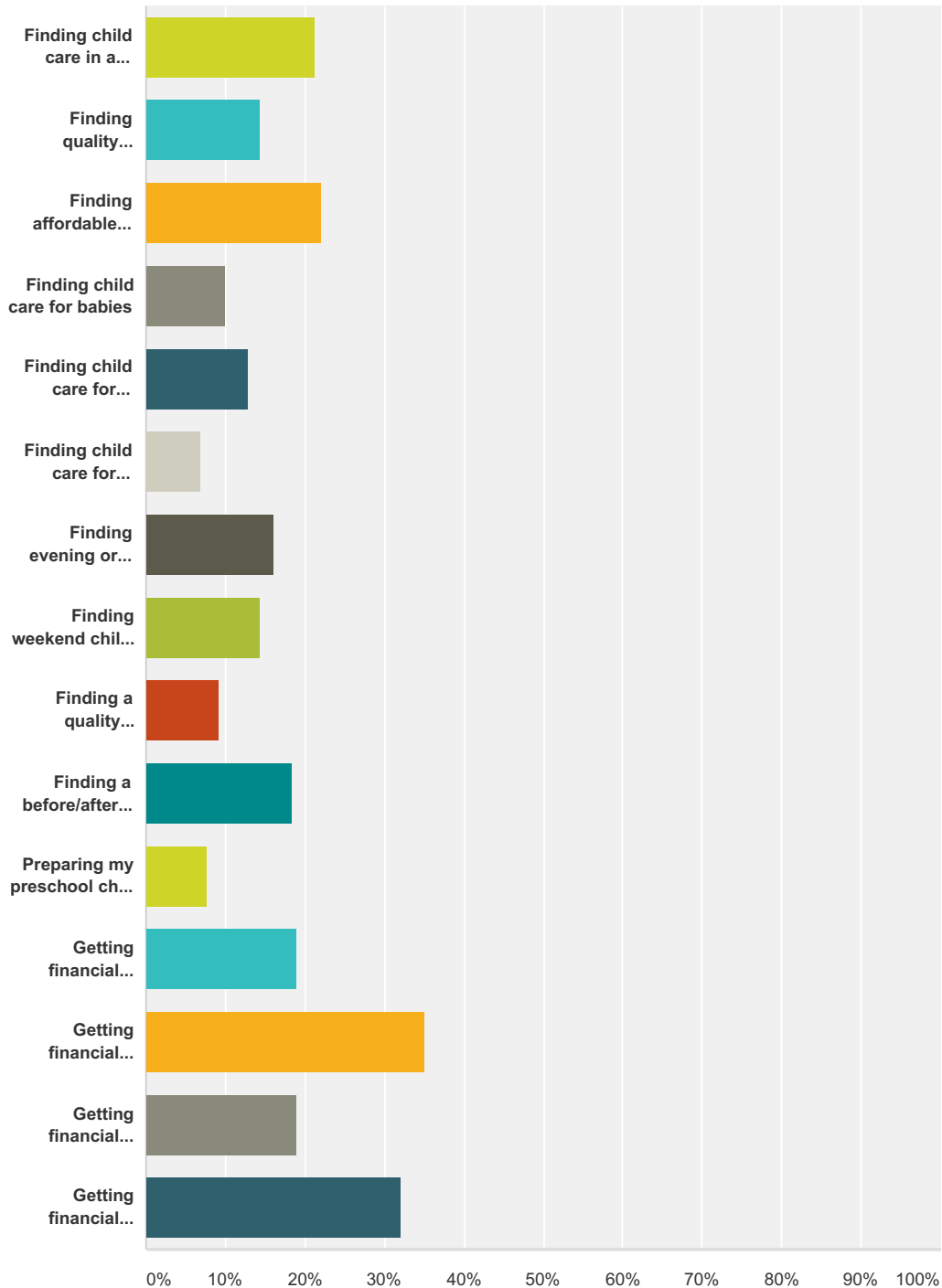

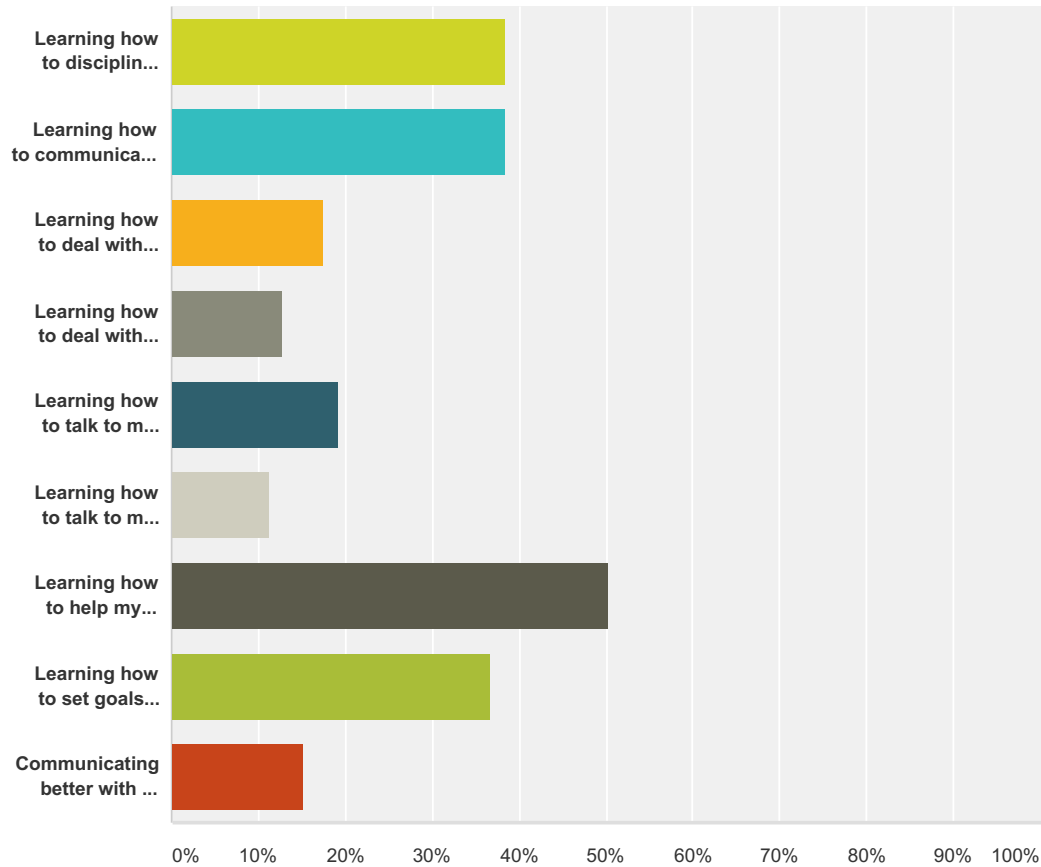

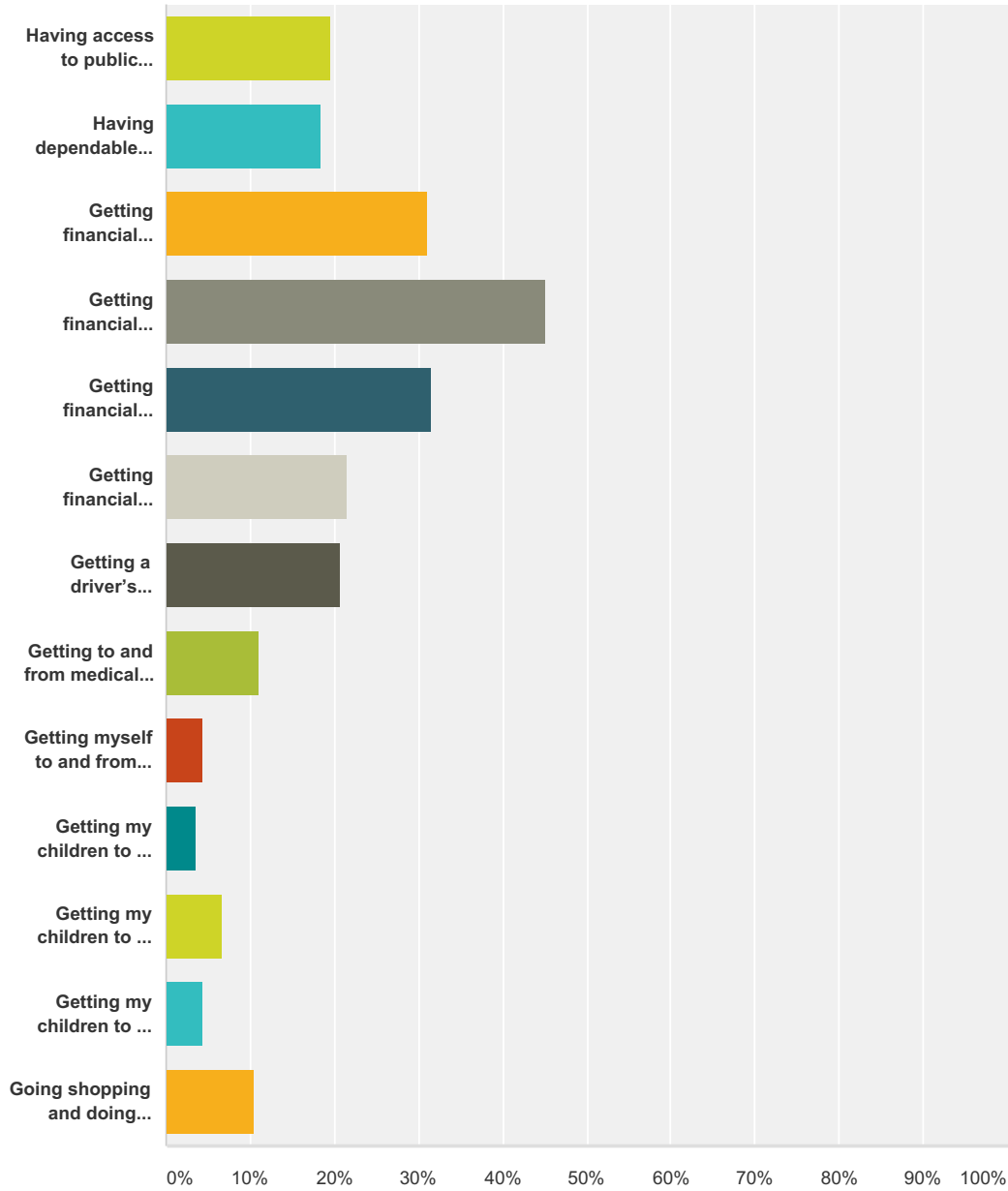

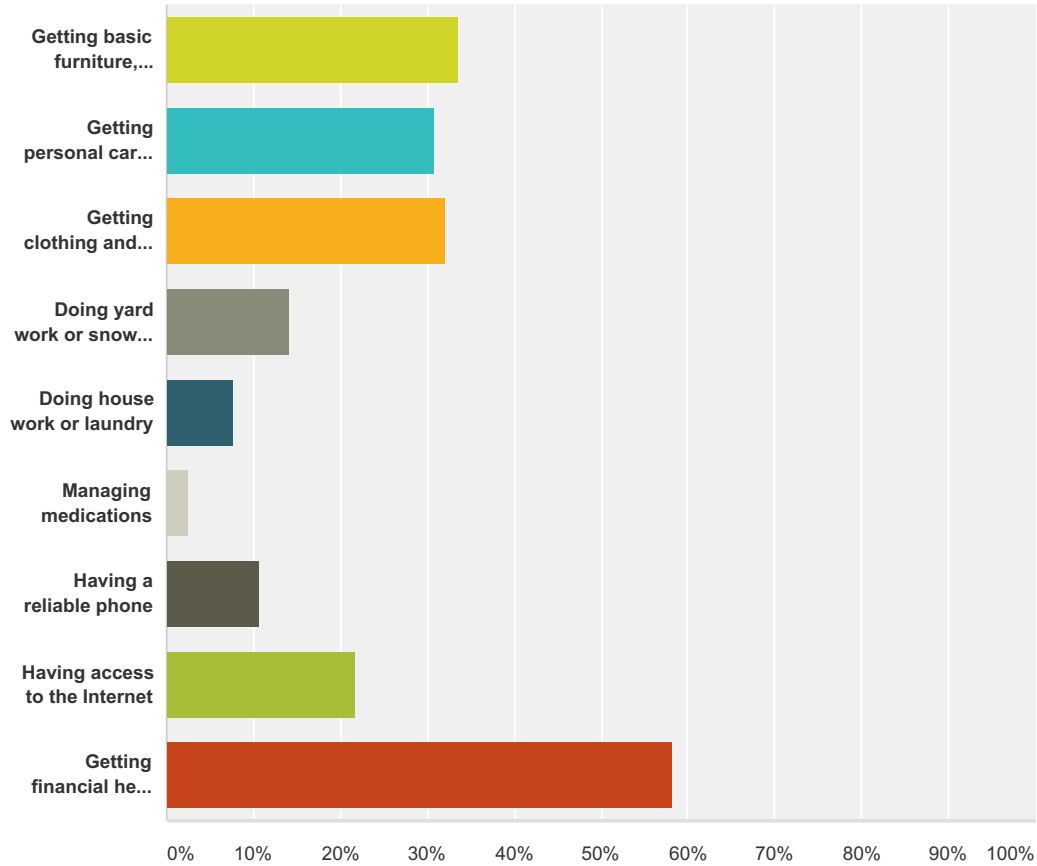

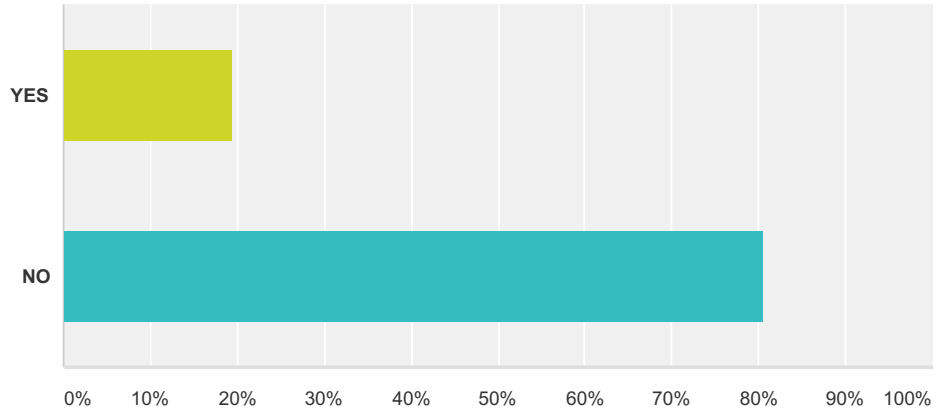

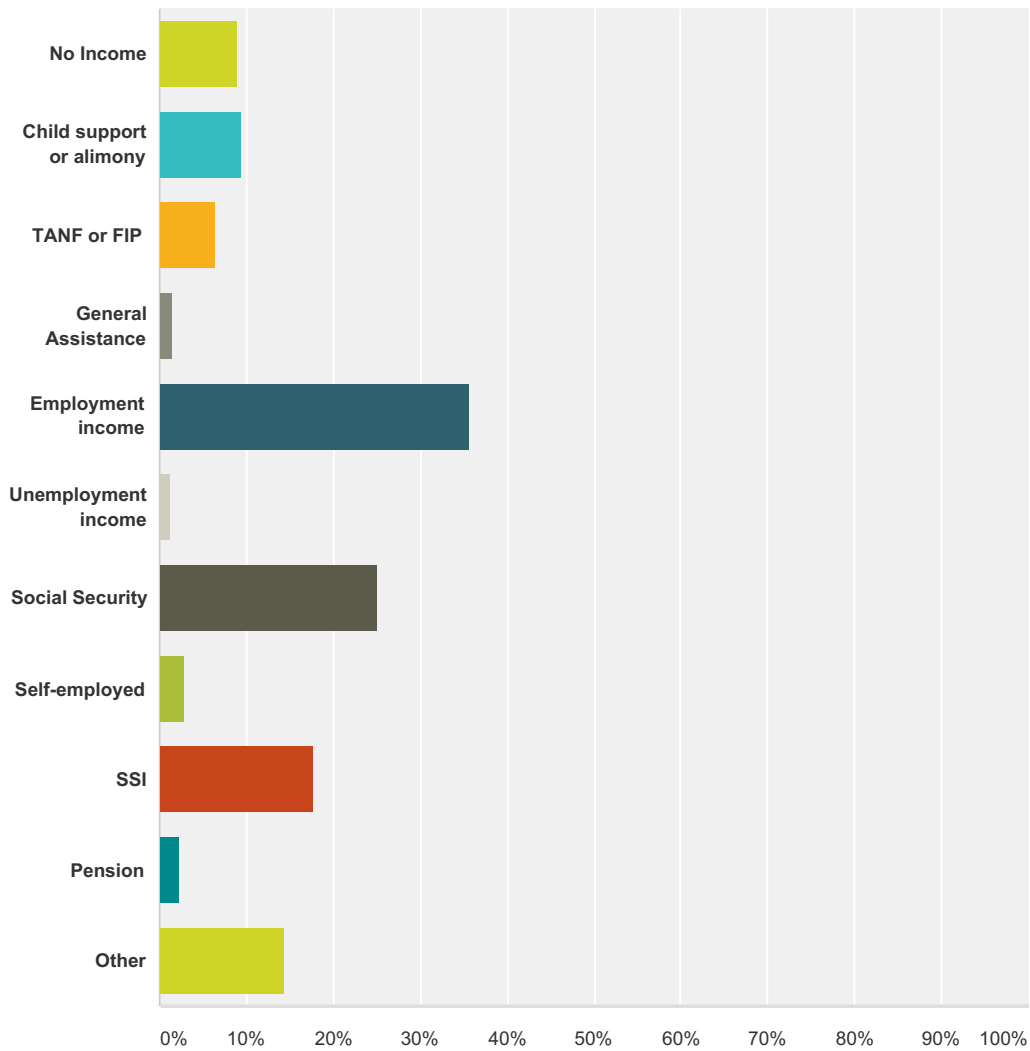

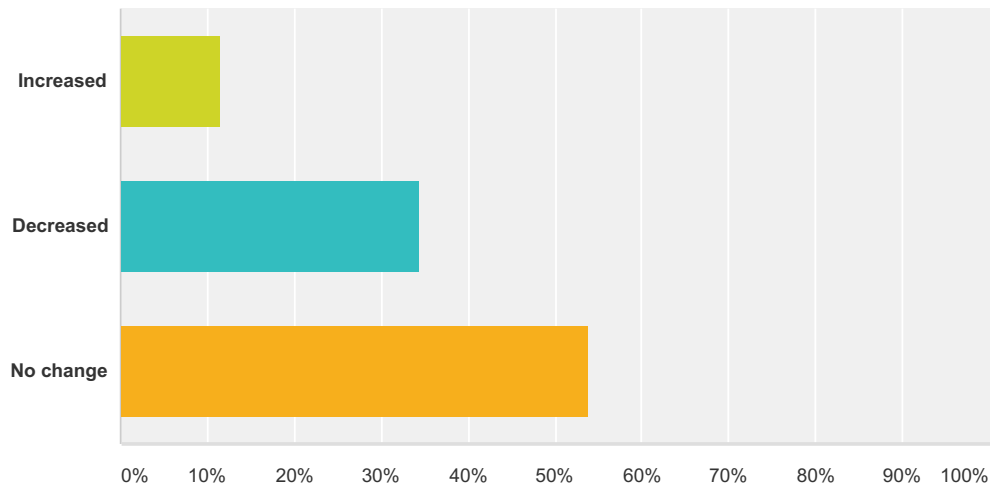

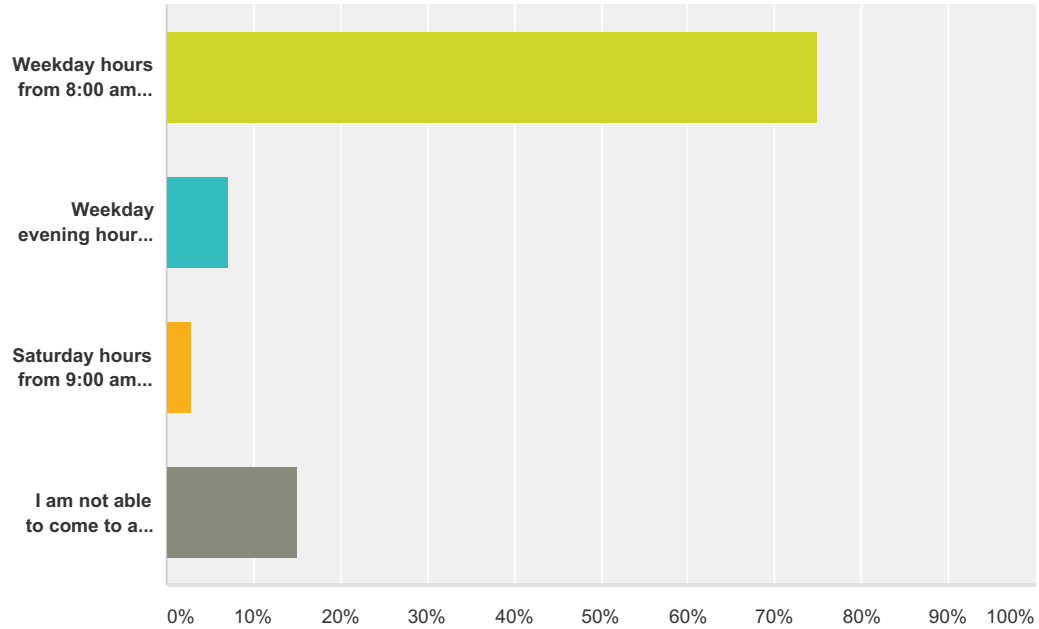

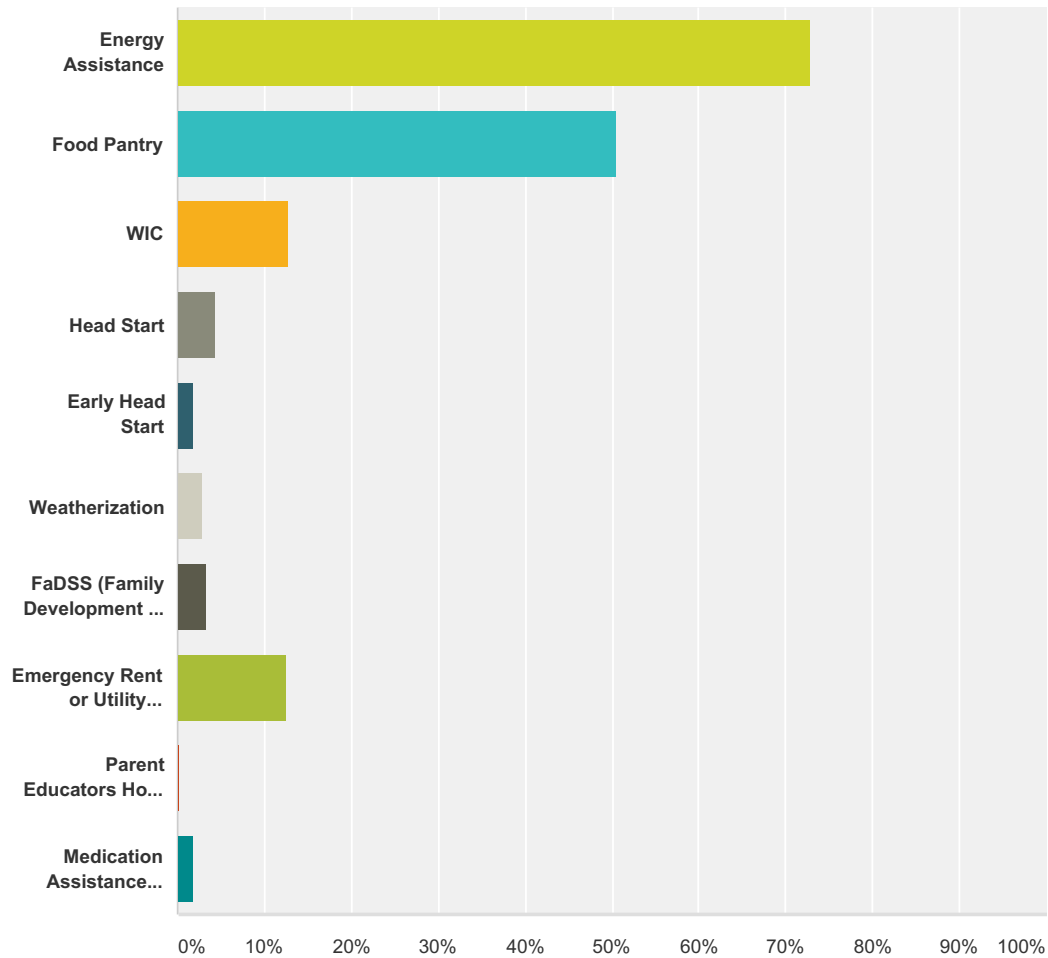

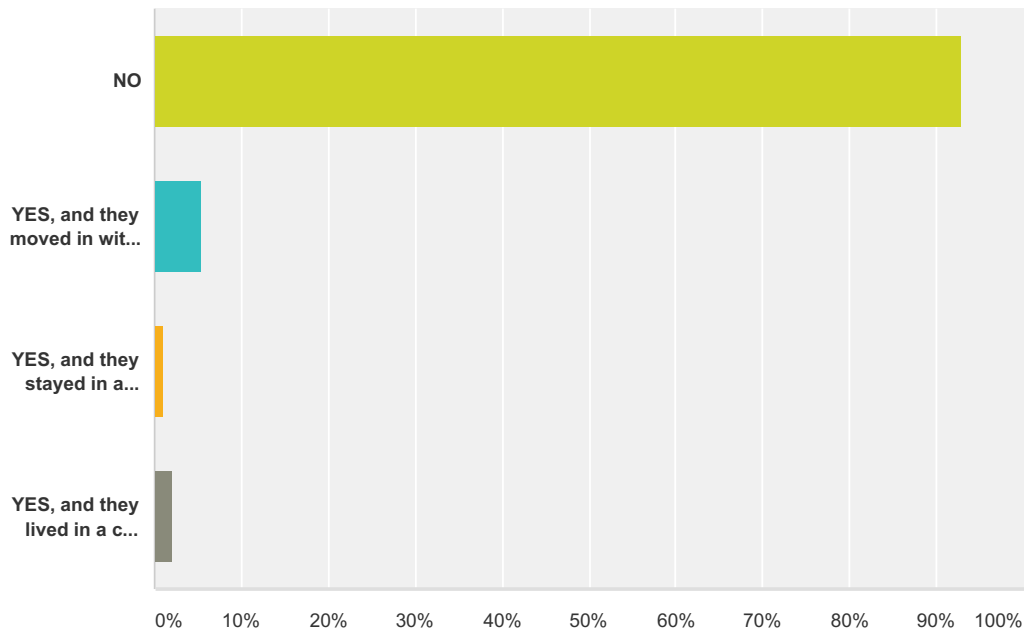

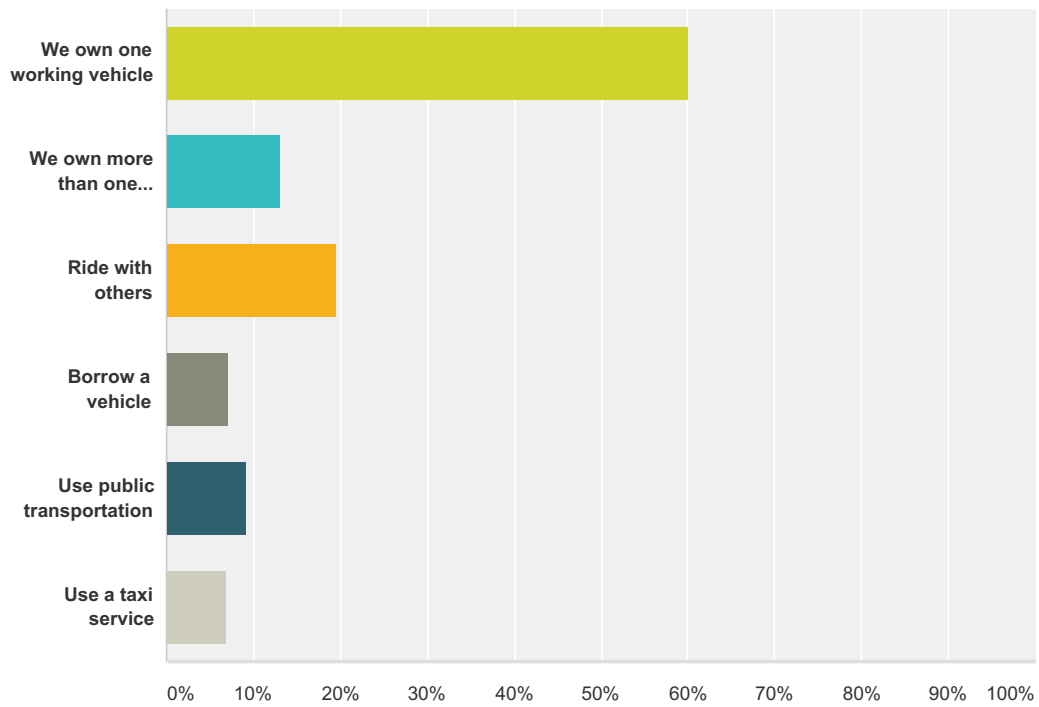

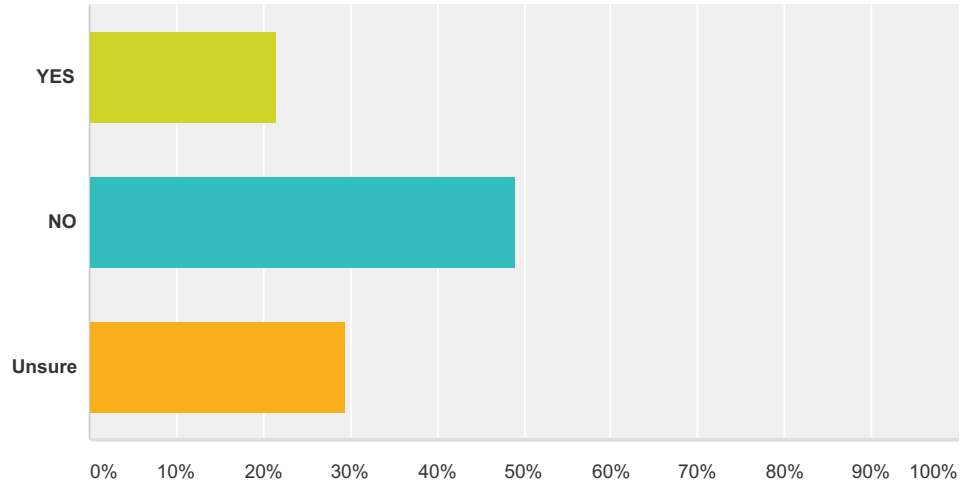

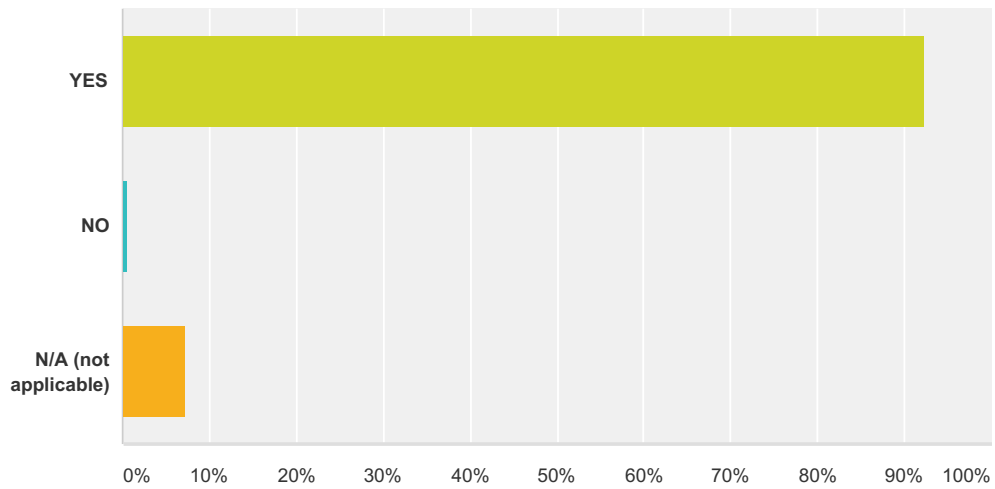

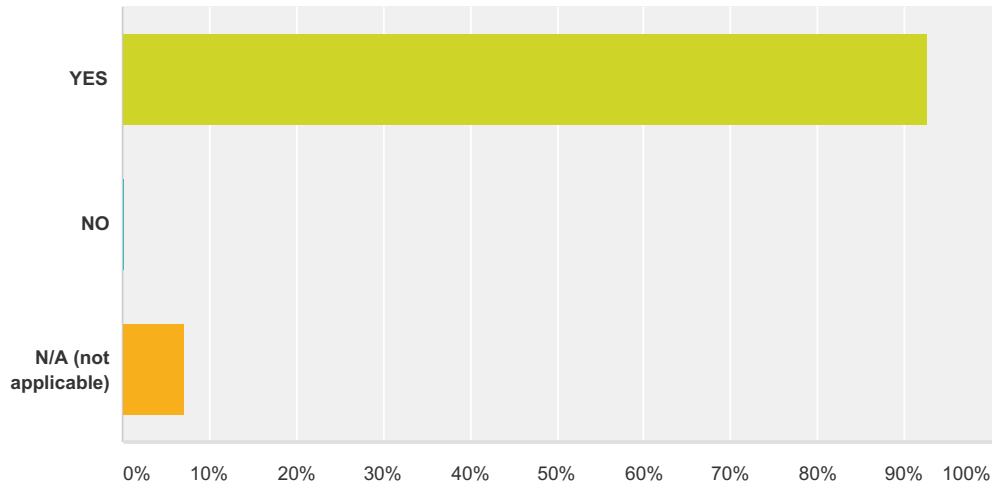

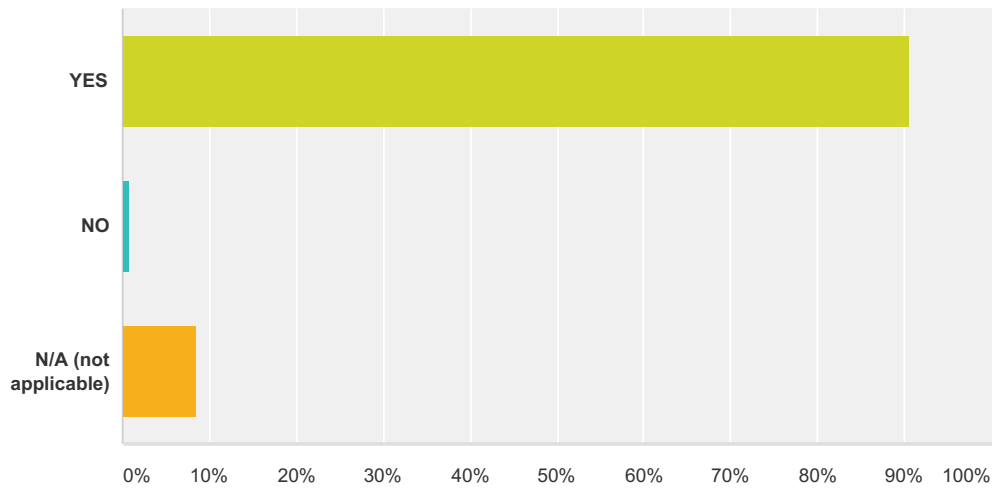

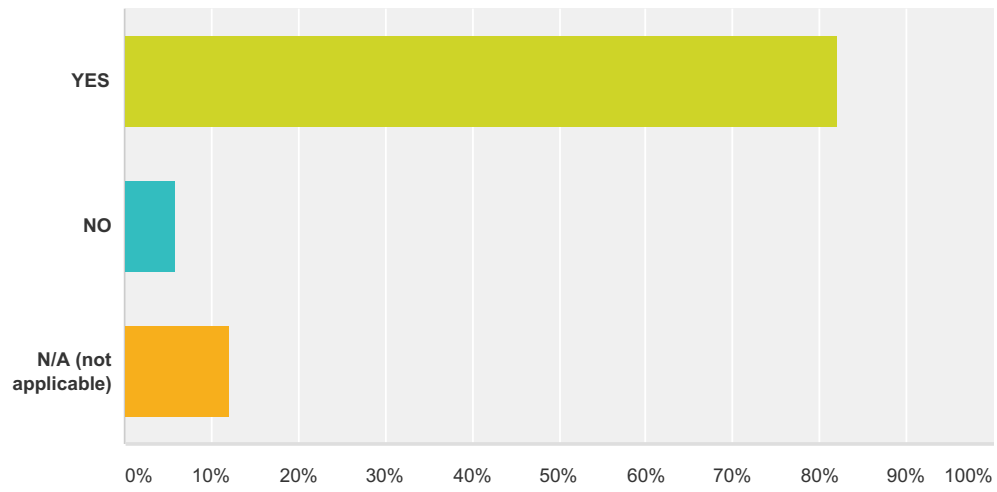
