Open Enrollment***

The Board voted to change our health insurance plan to Blue Choice with Wellmark, which begins on **March 1, 2018**. The premiums for employees who work 30 hours a week or more will remain at \$15 a pay period.

Our costs did increase 2.8 % which will result in a higher premium for family plans.

Although there will be a few differences when using the Blue Choice Plan, we were able to keep our deductibles and co-pays at the same level.

Open Enrollment to get on the plan is during the month of February, 2018 to be effective March 1, 2018. Contact Sandy Schafer at the Central Office to apply for coverage or for additional information.
