

Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)



Do you own or rent your home? The Iowa Department of Human Rights is once again offering the Home Energy Assistance Program through Community Action of Southeast Iowa. This program has been established to help qualified Iowa homeowners and renters pay for a portion of their primary heating costs.

WHEN TO APPLY:

- Elderly (60 & over) and/or disabled can apply beginning October 1, 2016
 - All other Households can apply beginning November 1, 2016
- *All Applications will be taken through April 28, 2017

WHAT TO TAKE WHEN YOU GO TO APPLY:

- Proof of income for the last 13 weeks or your most recent income tax return (2015 or 2016)
 - Recent heat bill
 - Recent electric bill
 - Birthdates of **all** household members.
- PROOF of Social Security numbers REQUIRED

Eligibility for participation is established according to the following Federal Household Income Guidelines:
