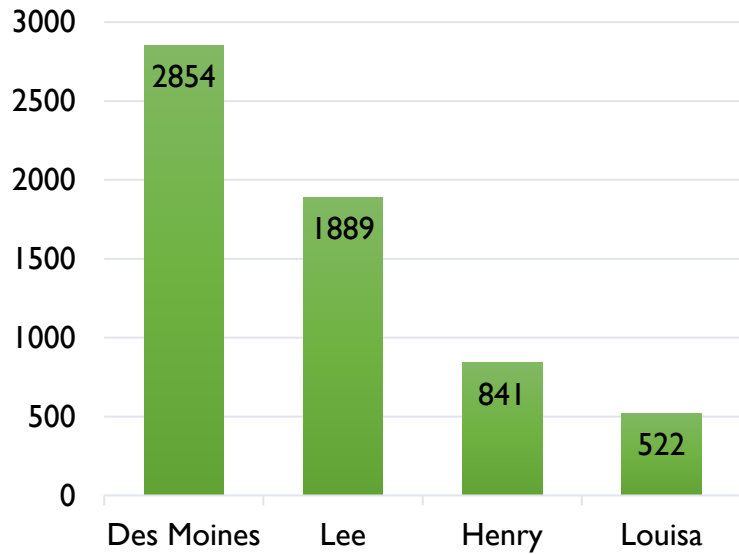
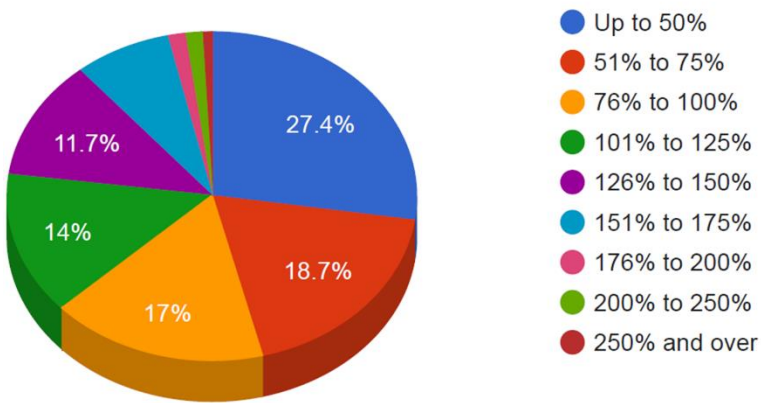


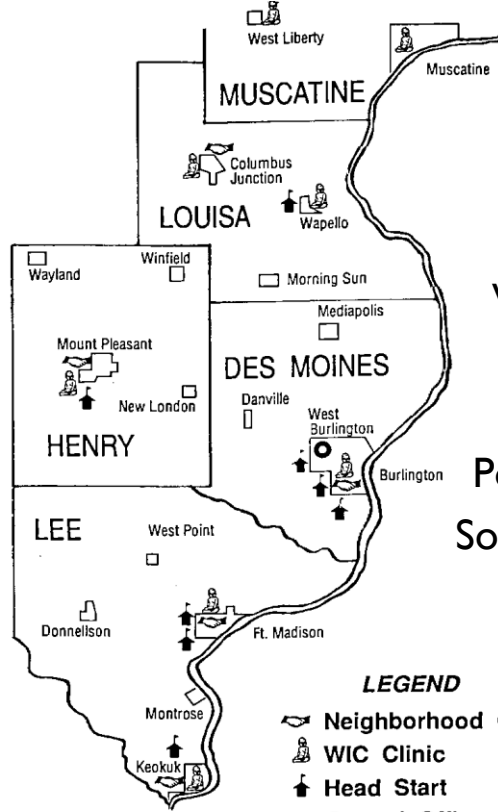
### Households Served by County

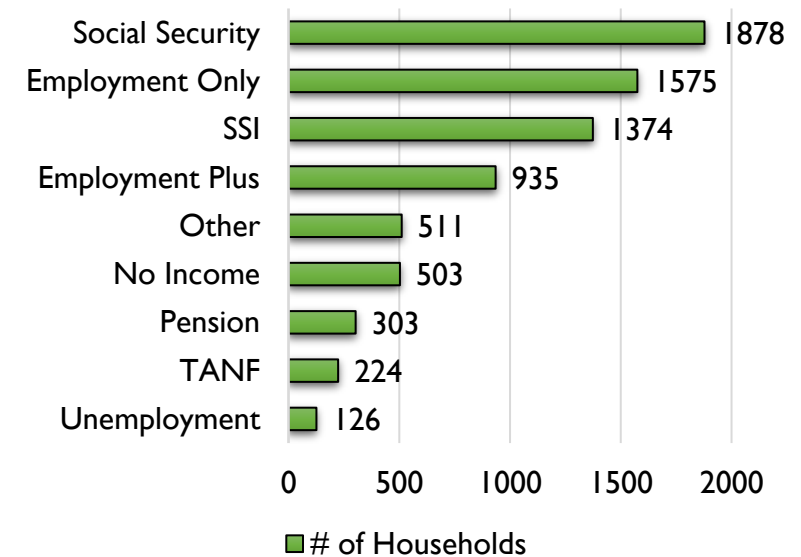

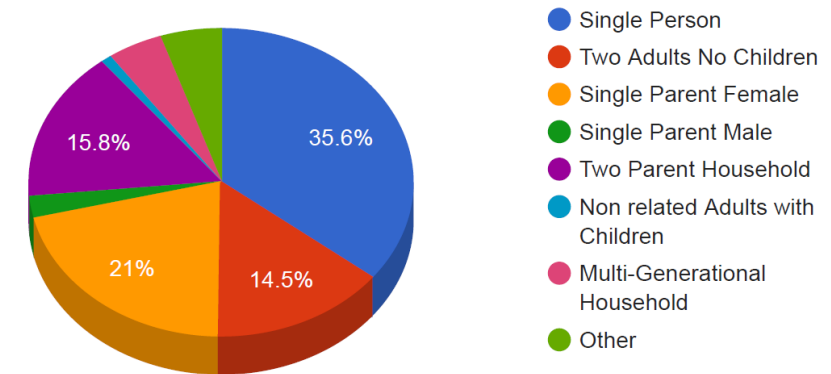
