

# PRESCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

Fiscal Year 2021-2022

Community Action of Southeast Iowa, Early Child Care Program, has received funding from Des Moines-Henry-Louisa-Washington (DHLW) Early Childhood Iowa to help families pay a portion of preschool costs. **\*As of November 2021, scholarships now cover 100% of the monthly tuition fees at most participating preschools.**

Funding is limited and families are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

- Must reside in Des Moines, Henry, Louisa, or Washington County.
- Children must be 3-5 years as of September 15<sup>th</sup>; not eligible past age six or before age three as of September 15<sup>th</sup>;
- Four (4) year olds must be denied or waitlisted for their local school district's free preschool program.
- Must enroll in an approved licensed preschool, per our requirements.
- Families must meet income eligibility requirements, see below.
