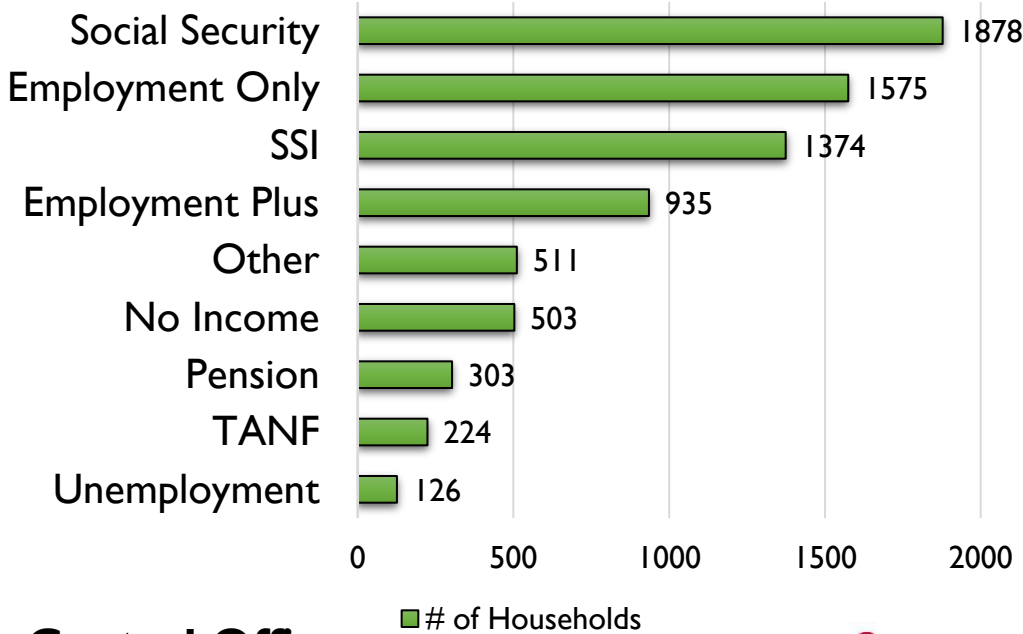

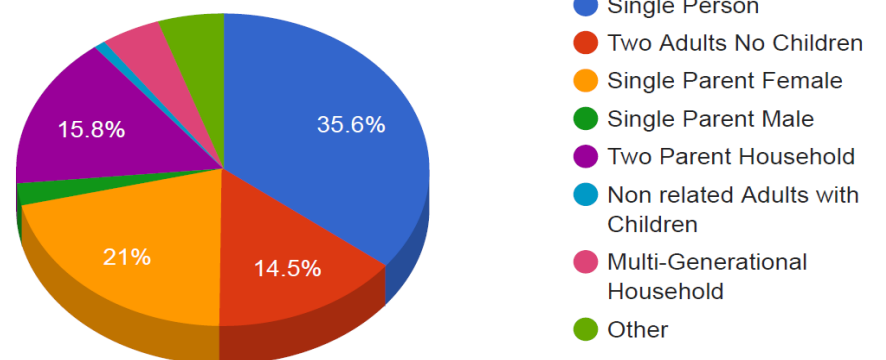

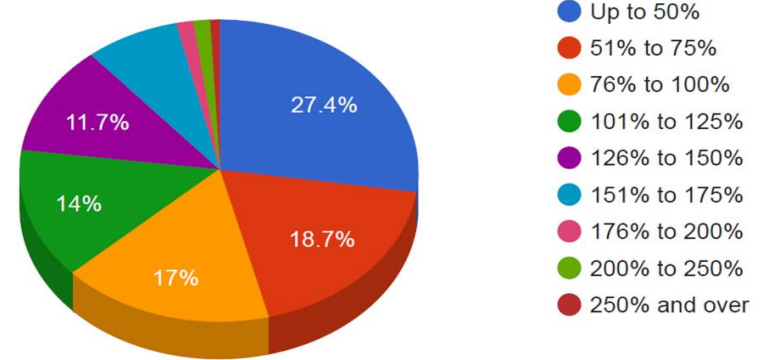
### Income Sources by Household

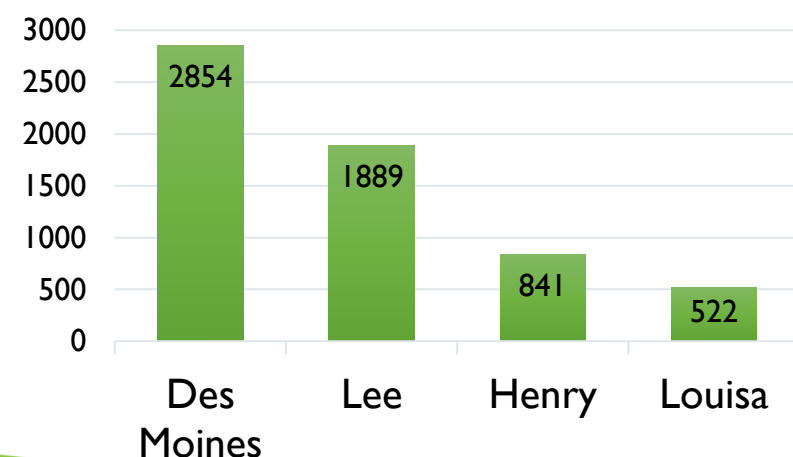
