PRESCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

Fiscal Year 2023-2024 *Anticipated funding – details subject to change*

Community Action of Southeast Iowa, Early Child Care Program, will again apply for funding from Des Moines-Henry-Louisa-Washington (*DHLW*) Early Childhood Iowa to help families pay a portion of their preschool tuition costs. <u>Funding is anticipated and not yet guaranteed, but we should know by July 1st</u>.

Funding will be limited and applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

- ✓ Families must reside in Des Moines, Henry, Louisa, or Washington County.
- ✓ Children must be 3-5 years old as of September 15th, 2023; they are not eligible past age six or before age three.
- ✓ Four (4) year olds must first be denied or waitlisted for their local school district's free preschool program.
- ✓ Families must enroll in an approved licensed preschool, per our requirements.
- ✓ Families must meet income eligibility requirements; see below.
- Three (3) and Four (4) year olds below our minimum income must first be denied or waitlisted for their local Head Start Program.
