206 Children in Head Start (HS) 104 Children in Early Head Start (EHS)

- 15% were HS eligible based on homelessness
 - 21% in EHS
- 6% in HS were dual language learners
 - o 2% in FHS
- 14% in HS were Black or African American
 - 11% in EHS
- 24% in HS were bi-racial/multi-racial
 - 15% in EHS
- 13% of HS children had a disability
- 18 pregnant women were enrolled in EHS services
- 65% of HS & EHS families were single parent families
- In HS there was a 52% increase in kids becoming up to date on their healthcare from program start to end
- 268 current or former HS parent volunteers
 - 312 total HS volunteers
 - 42 current or former EHS parents volunteers
